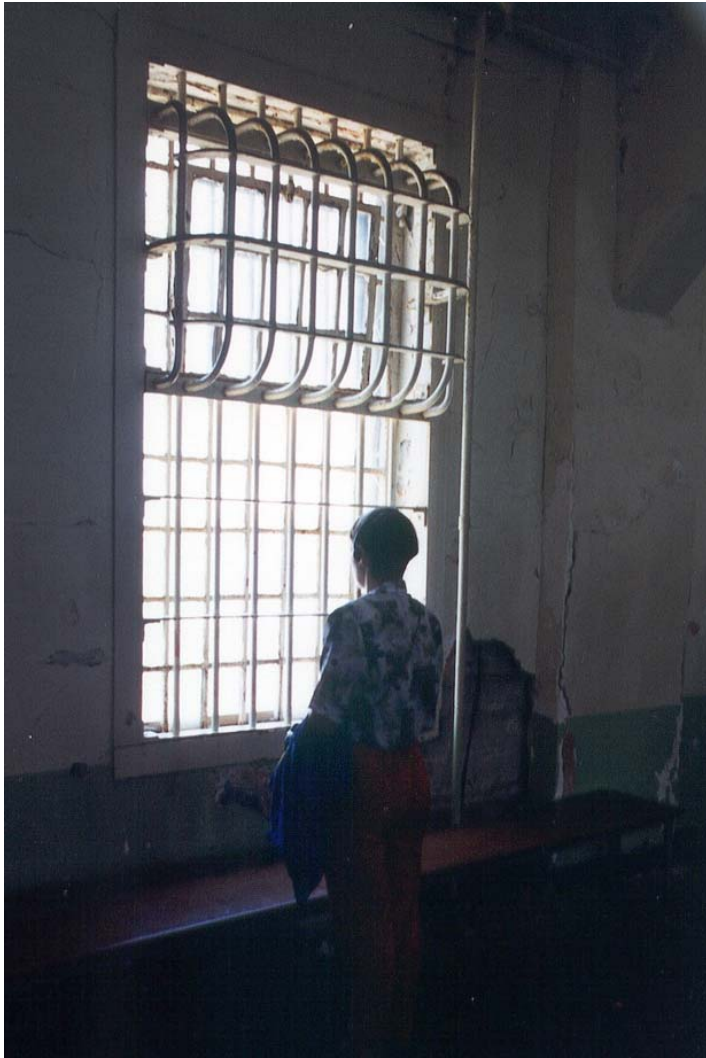


While I don't agree with much of what Ernest Hemmingway wrote, he was right about Big Game fishing - it's fun!
