We seem to be in a critical minority of two - we enjoyed the *Avengers* movie enormously!

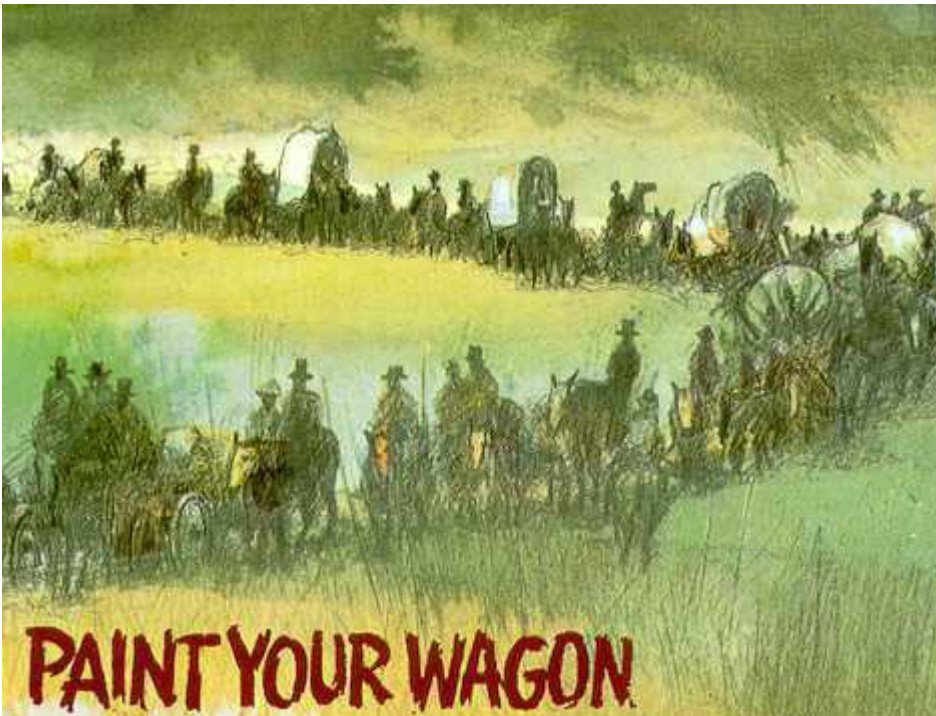
The villain's lair was an amalgam of Blenheim Palace and Syon House, so here's some rather atmospheric pictures of Blenheim.

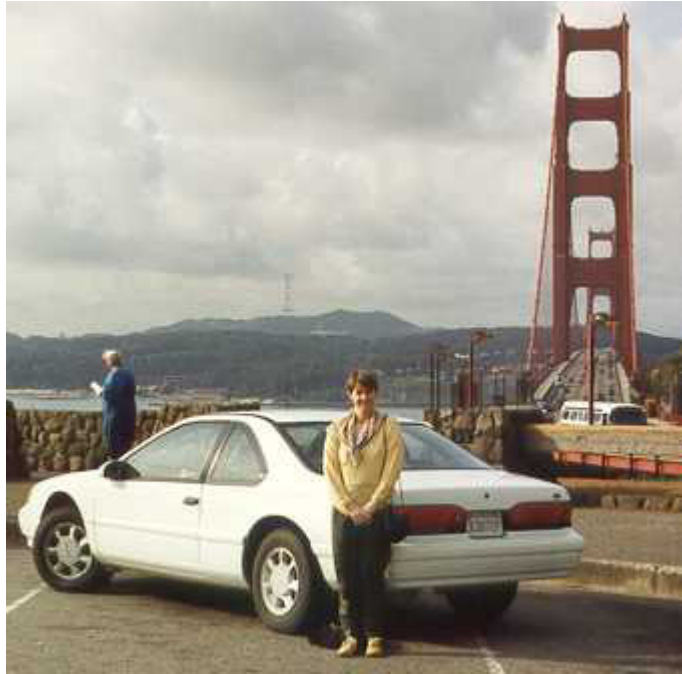
The X Files is almost entirely filmed in and around Vancouver, which manages to provide locations which pass as almost anywhere else in North America, or even the world.

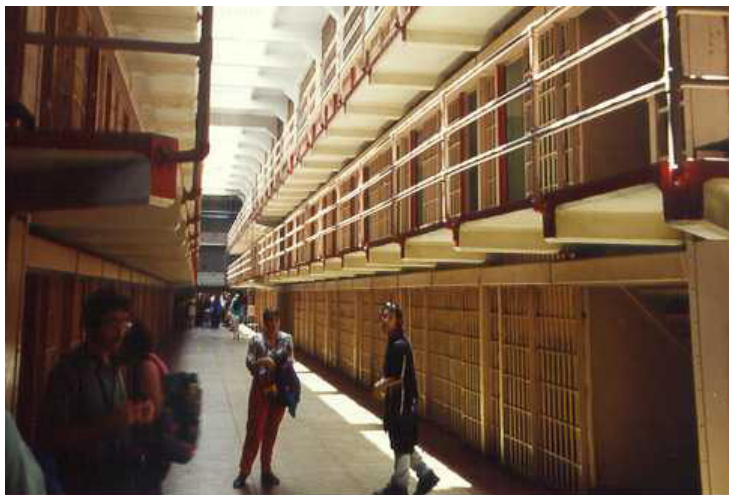
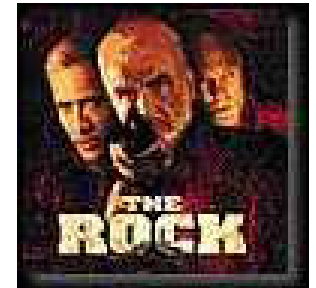

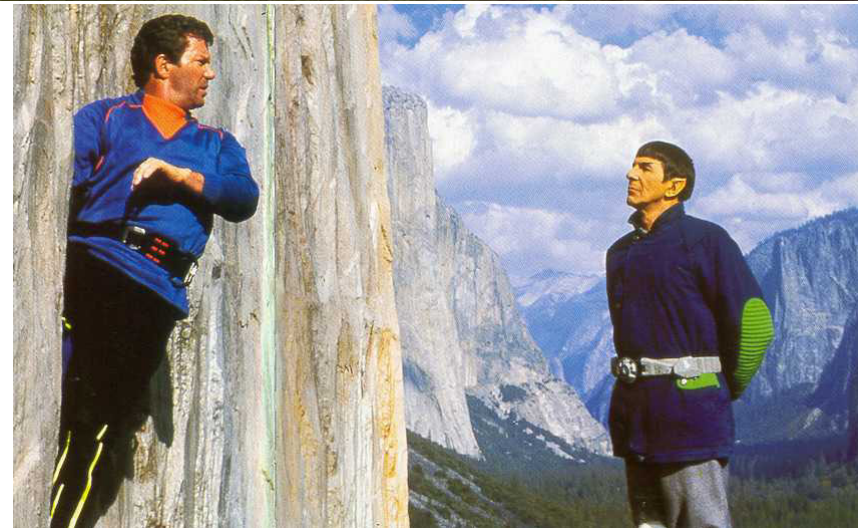
San Francisco must be the most-filmed city in the world. Even the local nick is famous - Alcatraz has been the setting for several films, most recently *The Rock*

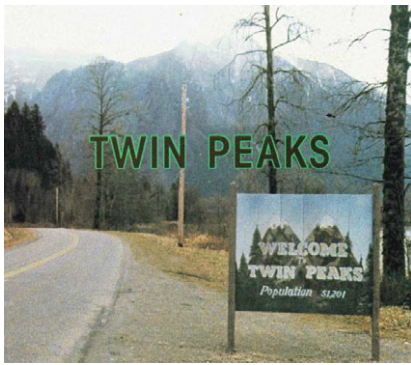
September 1999

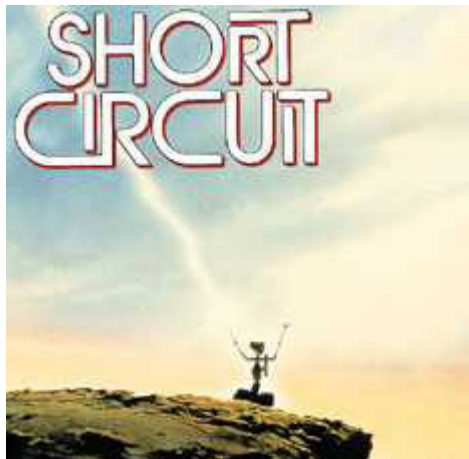


Astoria, on the Pacific coast of Oregon hosted two of our favourite films, *Short Circuit* and *Kindergarten Cop*.
